**SWORN STATEMENT**

I, [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] make this statement believing the contents to be true and understanding that it may be placed before the court as evidence.

1. I live at [REDACTED] which is directly opposite to Dominic's property at 3 Witney Road.
2. I am retired and am of good standing in the community.
3. I moved to a new build property in Witney Road at the same time as Dominic and his family in June 2013.

7. I was at home on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 and witnessed what happened on that day.
8. Louise was the aggressor who was shouting and swearing at Dominic whilst the children were in the house. I did not hear Dominic shouting at all. She was so loud it was horrendous.
9. Louise must have frightened the children by shouting. I was frightened myself.

11. I was visited by a police officer and gave a full statement in relation to the incident.

13. This was not the only occasion that Louise shouted and swore at Dominic. This was a regular occurrence. Louise has an explosive temper.
14. On one occasion Louise was shouting and acting aggressively over the trivial matter of car parking. Louise was shouting directly in my face. I thought that Louise was going to hit me. I was frightened. My husband Steve came out the house and defused the situation.
